Announcement and Registration Information

The Midland Figure Skating Club is delighted to invite you to the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Nonqualifying Competition to be held at the Midland Civic Arena in Midland, Michigan. This event will be held in conjunction with the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Regional Figure Skating Championships. We are planning for a wonderful week of skating, and hope the following information will answer your questions.

Rules/Conduct/Eligibility

Caveat: The rule numbers used in this document and on the appended forms and tables are those in the 2008 Rulebook and may be numbered differently in the 2009 Rulebook.

The 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Nonqualifying Competition is sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating and will be conducted by the rules set forth in the 2009 edition of the official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook and as set forth in this announcement. The purpose of a regional qualifying competition is to qualify skaters for Sectionals. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) is permitted by U.S. Figure Skating to host a nonqualifying competition in conjunction with the qualifying competition. However, the LOC is required by US Figure Skating to either limit the size of or be prepared to cancel certain events if they interfere with the qualifying competition. *Therefore, this nonqualifying competition may be restricted in size and, if so, competitors will be accepted on a "first-come, first served basis" by order of postmark date.* If no time limitation exists, the LOC may choose to hold final round events.

Events

2009 Eastern Great Lakes Nonqualifying Competition will include pre-juvenile boys and girls and open juvenile boys and girls free skate events only. Final rounds will be held if time permits. These events will be judged using the 6.0 system.

Pre-Juvenile: Skaters must have passed the pre-juvenile free skating test and no higher. Skaters will be grouped into flights by age. Test and program duration requirements will be as stated in Rule 3690 with well-balanced program requirements as stated in Rule 3691 in the 2009 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

Open Juvenile: Skaters must have passed the juvenile free skating test and no higher. Skaters must have reached 13 years of age or older by September 1, 2008. Skaters will be grouped into flights by age. Age, test, and program duration requirements will be as stated in Rule 3680 with well-balanced program requirements as stated in Rule 3681 in the 2009 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

Dates and Schedules

Open juvenile free skate events are tentatively scheduled for Monday, October 13, 2008 and pre-juvenile free skate events are tentatively scheduled for Tuesday October 14, 2008. Practice ice for these events will begin on Saturday, October 11, 2008.

The official schedule will be posted on our web site www.eglregionals2009.org when it is available. Please check the web site often for updates and the most current information.

Arena Details

The competition will be held at the Midland Civic Arena, 405 Fast Ice Drive, Midland, Michigan 48642, which is a new three sheet facility. The nonqualifying competition and most of the practice ice will be held on the South rink which is 200' x 85' with seating for 250. If needed, some practice ice may be scheduled on the North rink which is also 200' x 85'. Locker rooms will be available. (The qualifying competition will be held on the Olympic rink.) Please see our web site www.eglregionals2009.org for arena layout.

Online Electronic Registration (Required)

Online registration is the ONLY method available for entry into the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Nonqualifying Competition. All information normally required on a paper registration such as name, address, phone, e-mail, U.S. Figure Skating membership #, home club, event, sex, birth date, and highest free skating test passed will be required to be entered online. **Also required are coach's name, U.S. Figure Skating membership #, and PSA #.**

Note: the e-mail address entered will be used as the only means of contact with the competitor.

Procedure – Both Steps Must Be Completed Before Entry Deadline

1. Log on to www.eglregionals2009.org/nonqual. A username and password are required for successful online registration. Your username is your U.S. Figure Skating membership #. You will be prompted to enter a password and to verify it. After all required fields are complete and the SUBMIT button has been clicked, an automatic verification note will be sent to the e-mail entered.
2. Include registration amount of \$135 by check, sent with the **Additional Information Transmittal Forms**. *A copy of the skater's birth certificate and the Club, Parent and Coach Certification Form A-1 must also be included. See Form A for mailing instructions.*

Entry Fees

The entry fee for the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Regional Nonqualifying Competition is \$135 per event which includes a DVD for all events skated. Payment of the entry fee must accompany completed entry applications. Checks must be made payable to *MFSC Competitions*. No refunds will be given unless the event is not held or if the competitor is not accepted due to space limitations.

DEADLINES

The entry deadline is **11:59 p.m., September 1, 2008**. The time zone of your principal training center/primary residence will determine your entry deadline. **This deadline applies to both the submission of the online registration and the postmark of the Additional Information Transmittal Forms including the check.**

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE! NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DEADLINE! Register early to avoid problems and disappointment.

Age requirements must be met by **September 1, 2008**. Test requirements must also be met by **September 1, 2008**. Provisional entries based on passing a test after the closing date of entries will not be accepted.

Coaches

All coaches requesting credentials for the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Regional Nonqualifying Competition must be current, registered members of U.S. Figure Skating and the Professional Skaters Association.

Music

CDs are the only acceptable forms of media for the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Nonqualifying Competition. **Cassettes will NOT be accepted.** CDs must be clearly marked by **permanent pen** with name, event entered and the music length. **No labels stuck on CDs. Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it.** Any disc with more than one (1) track will NOT be accepted! Lead in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds. Each CD must be in a standard hard sided "jewel case" or CD sleeve, also labeled with the skater's name and event. Jewel cases and CDs that are not properly identified will NOT be accepted. **Due to compatibility and reliability reasons music may NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.**

Competition music must be turned in at the registration desk at the time of registration and will be available for pick up at the registration desk at the conclusion of the event. Competitors will not receive their credentials and will not be registered until they turn in their music.

Registration Desk

The official registration desk, located in the lobby, will be open throughout the championships. Competitors must register promptly upon arrival. Credentials and information packets will be handed to competitors upon receipt of the competitor's music. Coaches must register in person to receive their credentials.

Official Announcements

The Official Bulletin Board will be maintained near the registration desk at the Midland Civic Arena. The Official Schedule of Events will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board and will supersede all other schedules. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the Official Bulletin Board for event or schedule changes. The skating orders will be posted at the start of the first official practice for the competition.

Note: There will be a \$20 charge for returned checks, and skaters may not practice or compete until all funds have cleared.

Club, Parent and Coach Certification

A current officer of the skater's home club must certify that the skater is a full member in good standing of that club, and that s/he is eligible to compete in the appropriate event. (Individual members must certify their own forms.) The skater, and the parent if the skater is under 18, must sign authorization for emergency medical treatment and release of liability. The coach must sign that this form is complete and that the skater is eligible for the specified event. See **Form A-1**.

Practice Ice

Nonqualifying practice ice will begin on Saturday, October 11, 2008 and will be sold in 30 minute sessions. **Pre-purchased practice ice will cost \$12 per 30 minute session** if purchased with the Practice Ice Request Form postmarked by **September 1, 2008**. Pre-purchase of practice ice sessions will be limited to two sessions per day at the discretion of LOC based on availability. Please see **Form B**.

Online practice ice system: An online practice ice system will be available approximately September 15, 2008 through October 7, 2008. **Everyone who has pre-purchased practice ice will have those sessions assigned on a first come, first served basis, and will be notified by e-mail how to access those assignments online.** Directions will be posted on our web site www.eglregionals2009.org for purchasing **additional practice ice at \$15 per session**. Payments by check must be received by the Practice Ice Chair before the additional ice can be reserved.

Practice Ice Desk: The official Practice Ice Desk will be near the Registration Desk in the lobby. Additional practice ice can be purchased there for \$15 a session as available. If there is a line, then practice ice may be purchased for only one skater at a time.

All practice ice fees are nonrefundable and nontransferable.

Skater Information and Photograph for Program

Fill out personal information on the Program Information **Form C** and also submit all information **electronically with photo** to info@eglregionals2009.org. All photos must be identified with skater's first and last name and event level. The photo should be a headshot with a plain, light colored background.

Souvenir Programs and Pins

Both souvenir programs and trading pins will be available for pre-order and purchase at the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Regional Championships. Pre-order information is available on **Form D**.

Admission

The 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Regional Championships and the 2009 Eastern Great Lakes Nonqualifying Competition will be open to the public at a charge of \$15 per all-event ticket or \$7 per day. If purchased with skaters' application, prices are \$12 for all-event tickets or \$5 per day. Each skater will receive one competitor credential and two chaperone credentials included with their registration. See **Form E** for additional credentials.

Program Advertising and "Good Luck" Ads

Advertising in the 2009 EGLR official program is a wonderful way for your company, small business, or figure skating club to combine promotions with good wishes for skaters - see **Form F**. Personal "Good Luck" ads of 12 words or less are also available for only \$5 - see **Form G**.

Awards

Award medals will be presented to the 1st through 4th place winners in each event, including qualifying rounds. As soon as possible after results are posted, all winners should appear dressed in their competition outfits with skates on to participate in the awards ceremony. There will not be an awards photographer; parents and friends are encouraged to take their own pictures.

Videotaping

Performance videotaping for the EGL Nonqualifying Competition will be provided by Ledin Photo and Video. A DVD for each event skated will be provided for each skater at no additional charge. It is the responsibility of the skater to pick up these DVDs before the end of the competition. No personal videotaping will be allowed during any competition.

Competitors' Party

There will not be a Competitors' Party at this year's Eastern Great Lakes Regional Championships.

Location, Location, Location

Midland, Michigan

Midland is a small town with a big heart. It is very easy to get around with many friendly restaurants and interesting outdoor and indoor activities. The Midland Center for the Arts, Dow Gardens, Chippewa Nature Center, and the Alden B. Dow Home are just a few. Please check the Midland County Convention and Visitors Bureau web site www.midlandcvb.org for more ideas and information.

Important Note: Midland is in the Eastern Time Zone.

Transportation

The Midland Civic Arena is easily accessed just off US 10 at the southeast edge of Midland. It is conveniently located in the mid-Michigan Tri-City area of Midland, Bay City and Saginaw. If you are **driving**, we recommend using www.arenamaps.com for directions as some other mapping programs are not accurate for our new arena. Consult www.michigan.gov/mdot for road construction information.

Air Transportation

There are several options for flying into the Midland area. The most convenient is MBS Airport which is nine miles from the Midland Civic Arena and is served by Northwest and United Airlines. MBS stands for Midland, Bay City, Saginaw, and flights here will be listed under Saginaw on the airport monitors. Other nearby airports include Bishop International Airport in Flint which is 60 miles from the arena with AirTran, American, Continental, Delta, Midwest, and Northwest Airlines. Also, Detroit Metropolitan Airport is served by most major airlines and is about 100 miles from the arena.

Transportation Security Administration (TSA)

The TSA of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has very strict screening guidelines for transporting sports equipment. It prohibits certain sporting equipment from being brought on-board an aircraft, including equipment determined at the discretion of the security screener to be dangerous, which may include ice skates. While these items may be PROHIBITED from your carry-on luggage, they may be transported to your destination in your checked baggage. Any sharp objects in checked baggage should be sheathed or securely wrapped to prevent injury to baggage handlers and security screeners and/or damage to other luggage. Please reference the web site below for an outline of items that are permitted and prohibited in your carryon and/or checked baggage.

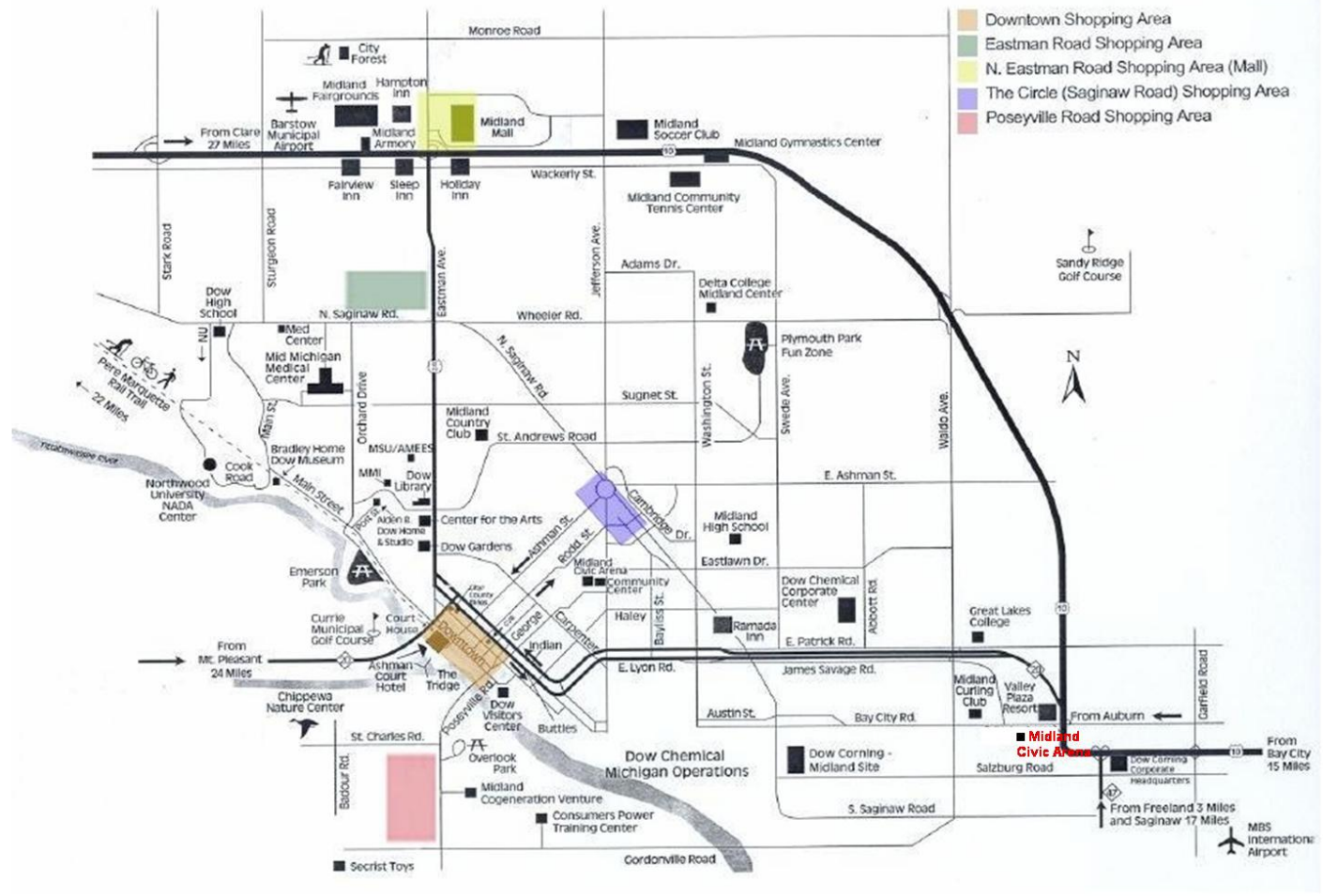
